

Your private hire licence

If you do not already have a private hire licence, to join Parkers you will need to obtain one from Reigate and Banstead Borough Council, the local authority covering the area in which Parkers is based. This will cover you for all the assignments you undertake for Parkers.

As a quick guide, as a first time private hire licence applicant you will need:

- to be aged over 21
- to have held a full driver's licence issued by Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA) or by a European Union country for at least 12 months.

To apply for your licence, you will need to complete an application form and provide various supporting documents including a Disclosure and Barring Service check and a medical report. You will also have to pass a knowledge test covering issues including the ability to read a map and plan a route; dealing with money and fares; the Highway Code.
